Choose your Brunel course and register your details with UCAS

Need help deciding on a course? Use our course finder tool to assist you.

2

Apply for your chosen course through UCAS

When completing your application, include all your GCSE and A-level (or equivalent) grades and course information (including the modules you're studying) so that we have everything we need to assess your application and come back to you with a decision.

3

Relax. We're working hard on assessing your application so there's no need to do anything unless we contact you for more information

We'll email you if:

- We need further information in order to assess your application
- Your application has been referred to the academic department for further review
- Your course requires an interview or audition, or you need to submit a portfolio
- You have to complete a Fee Status Questionnaire (FSQ) - this is to help us determine whether you should be treated as a home or international student for fee paying purposes. If you receive an FSQ, you will also be provided with some guidance on how to complete this

Congratulations, you've been offered a place at Brunel!

You'll receive an offer email from us confirming the outcome of your application. UCAS will also email you when they have been updated with an outcome.

Make your decision

Read your offer email carefully, and consider this offer along with any other offer you receive to decide which is the right course and university for you.

Accept your offer

Once you've decided to make Brunel your firm choice, simply log into [UCAS Track](#) and accept your offer.

Apply for accommodation on campus

You can apply for accommodation at Brunel as soon as you've received an offer, but you won't be able to book anything until your offer becomes unconditional (after you've received your results). No need to worry though, all new students are guaranteed on campus accommodation at Brunel!
